### SPECIFICATIONS

#### Section 01300 – Bid Form

Page 1, Paragraph 5: Change the last sentence to read “..... general conditions within **540** calendar days and complete all obligations within **570** calendar days.”

Page 1, Paragraph 6: Change the first sentence to read “..... work is not completed within **570** calendar days for all work associates with this project.”

#### Section 01400 – General Requirements

Paragraph 1.5.2: Delete “(attached)” and replace with “(at the end of Section 01400 – General Requirements)”.

#### Between Section 01400 – General Requirements and Section 01500 – Supplementary Conditions

Delete Project Manual pages 29, 30 and 31 which starts with “procurement decisions.....” and ends with “2 CFR Appendix-II-to-Part-200(L) (enhanced display). Replace these pages with the enclosed “Attachment 1”.

### DRAWINGS

#### Drawing E-1 – Partial Power Distribution Diagram, Legend, Abbreviations, General Notes

Add the following General Note:

“8. The Contractor is advised that all motors and controllers that are indicated on these drawings and specifications shall be provided with electrical power breakers, power wiring, conduit, control wiring and conduit, regardless whether indicated on the drawings, or not in accordance with the National Electric Code.”

**ARPA TREASURY FINAL REGULATIONS**

Furthermore, among other requirements contained in 2 CFR 200, Appendix II, all contracts made by a recipient or subrecipient in excess of \$100,000 with respect to water, sewer, or broadband infrastructure project that involve employment of mechanics or laborers must include a provision for compliance with certain provisions of the Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act, 40 U.S.C. 3702 and 3704, as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR Part 5).

Treasury will continue to seek information from recipients on their workforce plans and water, sewer, and broadband projects undertaken with SLFRF funds. This reporting will support transparency and competition by enhancing available information on the services being provided.

**2 CFR APPENDIX II TO PART 200(E)**

- (E) Contract Work Hours and Safety Standards Act (40 U.S.C. 3701-3708). Where applicable, all contracts awarded by the non-Federal entity in excess of \$100,000 that involve the employment of mechanics or laborers must include a provision for compliance with 40 U.S.C. 3702 and 3704, as supplemented by Department of Labor regulations (29 CFR Part 5). Under 40 U.S.C. 3702 of the Act, each contractor must be required to compute the wages of every mechanic and laborer on the basis of a standard work week of 40 hours. Work in excess of the standard work week is permissible provided that the worker is compensated at a rate of not less than one and a half times the basic rate of pay for all hours worked in excess of 40 hours in the work week. The requirements of 40 U.S.C. 3704 are applicable to construction work and provide that no laborer or mechanic must be required to work in surroundings or under working conditions which are unsanitary, hazardous or dangerous. These requirements do not apply to the purchases of supplies or materials or articles ordinarily available on the open market, or contracts for transportation or transmission of intelligence.
